

INFORMATION ON RETIRING BOD MEMBERS

Andrew Sansome, M SAE-A

Andrew was elected to the Board of Directors at the 11 May 2004 AGM and was re-elected to serve a second consecutive term at the 29 May 2007 AGM. Under the terms of the SAE-A Constitution, Andrew retired from the BOD at the 18 May 2010 AGM.
