Student Membership

You need to be a student member of SAE-A to compete in the Formula SAE-A competition.

The membership year runs from the 1st Jan - 31st December, so in order to get the most out of your membership we recommend that you apply or renew your membership now.

CAMS Information

In accordance with CAMS rules **ALL DRIVERS** are required to obtain **Level 2S CAMS licences**.

Single event licence will be made available for FSAE-A.

What is a "Single event licence"?

A single event licence is a licence issued for only one event, in this case FSAE-A. This licence will cost \$ 57.00. In the event you choose to renew your licence with CAMS for a full 12 months you are able to do that with CAMS directly and they will only charge you the difference. Please contact CAMS for more information regarding full licences. The Single event Licence forms will be issued at registration on Thursday December 15th at the event. **CASH PAYMENT ONLY (AUSTRALIAN DOLLARS) will be accepted** and you will then be issued with your single event licence. For all other CAMS licence enquiry you MUST contact CAMS directly.

Preparation for this year's event is going well with all event captain positions filled, so now we seek volunteers for each event. I encourage anyone who has been involved as a competitor to consider this and if interested contact Michela for the registration form.

Following on from a very successful 2010 event, we have received feedback from many quarters on *how to further improve the event. These ideas have been ranked, costed, prioritised and where possible are being implemented. Such feedback is very important and we encourage teams to direct their views through your facility advisor and on to SAE-A so it can be given proper review, it all helps us to help you*

TECHNICAL INSPECTION

This year we are building on our experience from last year and will have a total of 4 lanes operating on Friday, 3 for the scheduled inspection, 1 for repeats

Thursday:

Teams ranked 1 – 6 in the overall results from 2010 will be assessed in that order between 3pm – 5pm.

Friday:

Teams from Thursday who were not seen will be assessed in the "repeat" lane.

The remaining teams will be allocated a time similar to Cost, Presentation and Design to adhere to, this schedule will be published some weeks before the event

Each team will be allocated 1 hour.

If you miss your allocated slot, you will have to wait in line as per other years, the problem will be that you may not be seen when you are ready, so obviously the most efficient way is to stick to your scheduled time by having your car ready early. We also encourage teams, where possible, to present the car on time even if the car is not 100% completed, that way at least some elements of the vehicle can be assessed.

Saturday:

Any teams which don't pass on Thursday / Friday will be seen on a first come first served
